What's Going On?

Mayor Ford and city managers are preparing to lock out workers and skaters from Dufferin Rink! How can we avoid losing access to our neighbourhood services?

Despite a budget surplus of over \$150 million (and climbing!), the City is no closer to negotiating a fair deal with city workers. Mayor Ford's commitment to pushing through privatization instead will be felt right here at Dufferin Rink.

If City workers get locked out from driving zambonis to clear ice on February 5th, the union plans to help to make sure skaters can still use the rink! But will the City shut the compressors off and lock the gates?

What is at Stake?

The City wants to privatize service jobs, like they have already done with West end garbage collection. If city workers don't agree to let the city sell off decent jobs — provided by skilled workers — to private companies paying minimum wage, Mayor Ford and city managers will lock workers and the public out. But can you really run a park like a Coffee Time? We don't think so.

Mayor Ford's administration needs to reach out to residents to share the responsibility of managing our neighbourhood services — start there!
