Fire Pit Permit Process

The permit request is made through our Customer Service Permit Call Centre by calling 416-392-8188

Client selects a facility with a fire pit - Site is a designated fire pit (fire approved annually)

- Step 1. Customer Service will review site availability.
- Step 2. If available, the permit and insurance is issued to the client. Payment and clients signature is required at time of booking.
- Step 3. Permit process is complete.

Client selects a facility with a fire pit - Site is NOT designated as a fire pit (NOT pre-approved by Toronto Fire Services)

- Step 1. Customer Service forwards by Toronto Fire Services Form & Parks Protocol Form to customer to complete
- Step 2. Once approved by Toronto Fire Services, Customer Service will then contact the client and issue a permit.
- Step 3. Permit must be signed and paid.
- Step 4. Permit process is complete.
